## Event Info & Details

We heard you might be interested in participating in one of the events we host here at Greasy Creek General Store! We'd love to have you! Here is a little info about each event type:

### 1800's Day Spring Fest:

This event centers around the old-fashioned lifestyle of people from the 1800's, featuring things like making lye soap, what it was like to plow with mules, blacksmithing, weaving, and other activities from daily life 100+ years ago. We also promote canning, planting gardens, and other modern activities that preserve the heritage of our ancestors.

This event is not so much a "craft show" as it is a display of information and demonstration. Having products for sale is welcome, but please adhere to our handmade/homemade rule. We also ask that you dress up in era attire, if possible, and come prepared to demonstrate and educate people about the craft, trade, and/or products you're displaying.

The standard booth fee will be \$20, but if paid a month in advance, you'll receive a 25% discount.

### Fall Festival Craft Show:

Our fall event started out as a simple open house for the store, but now centers around a craft show that features local artists, handmade crafts, and primitive trades.

Due to our old-fashioned theme, we reserve our grounds to exclusively feature only handmade crafts or items created by our vendors, and do require your products to be of this nature. If you are interested in only demonstrating or providing information about an old-fashioned profession or trade, please contact us about this as well!

The standard booth fee will be \$20, but if paid a month in advance, you'll receive a 25% discount.

### Christmas Open House:

Our Christmas Open House takes place on the first weekend of November. Friday night is our night to set out Christmas products and invite the community out for hot cider and a light show. Saturday, we invite direct sales reps, retail businesses, and craft vendors to come set up on our grounds and showcase their products for a huge Christmas Shopping weekend!

This is different from our fall event in that it is not limited to craft vendors. Our handmade/homemade rule does not apply for this event so that other businesses can join us for a Christmas Open House shopping weekend.

The standard booth fee will be \$15.

### Weekend Set-up:

Throughout the year, we have space and resources available to feature local artists and artisans who would like to set up on our grounds to demonstrate or teach primitive crafts and/or trades from the early days of our country. We provide advertising and location, and are able to set up covered booths for this purpose.

For these events, we ask that you dress appropriately for the era you demonstrate, if possible. You are welcome to offer products you make for sale, as well.

Please contact Coley to set up a workshop class or demonstration.

### Area Church Bakesale & Picnic:

Who doesn't like ice cream and baked goods? During this event, we reserve our grounds for area churches to set up and sell baked goods, homemade ice cream, and other home-cooked foods. We then invite the community to join us for a community picnic experience while supporting local churches.

There is no booth fee, and vendors keep all proceeds they raise during this fund-raiser. Again, this is a fund-raiser event for local churches.
